The finalized new policies for Medicare drug plans will begin January 1, 2019 and include improved safety alerts when prescriptions are dispensed at the pharmacy, and drug management programs to better coordinate care when chronic high-risk opioid use is present. The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) has issued a Health

Advisory warning physicians of a Hepatitis A Virus (HAV) outbreak in Pennsylvania and neighboring states. Officials are encouraging health care professionals to increase vaccinations and screenings for high risk patients. The outbreak is highest among patients reporting drug use and/or homelessness.
