As a result of the recent measles nationwide outbreak, many questions are being asked about the need for a Mumps, Measles, Rubella (MMR) booster shot. According to the CDC, there is no evidence that immunity to the measles virus wanes over time. New Part D Opioid Overutilization Policies

CMS implemented new opioid policies for Medicare drug plans which came in to effect on January 1. Medicare Part D opioid policies are not prescribing limits and generally do not apply to enrollees who have cancer, receive hospice, palliative, or end-of-life care, or who live in a long-term care facility. The new policies encourage collaboration and care coordination among Medicare drug plans, pharmacies, prescribers, and patients to improve opioid management, prevent opioid misuse, and promote safer prescribing practices.
